Invitation for Application for Journalists Work Scholarship in Schleswig-Holstein/Germany

The Foundation of the Kiel Press Club announces work scholarships for two journalists affected by the war in Ukraine.

The aim of the work scholarship in Northern Germany is to offer new opportunities for professional practice, to get to know journalists and the various media in Schleswig-Holstein as well as their training institutions, and to build up a new journalistic network at the same time. The scholarship includes residency in state capital Kiel and is limited to four weeks, if possible in October/November 2022.

During this time, short internships are offered at the media and training institutions based in Kiel, contact to media institutions in Northern Germany and support with reporting. The choice of topic of their reporting is left to the participants of the work stay. A report on people who fled from the Ukraine to Schleswig-Holstein and are currently living here is desirable.

The Kiel Press Club Foundation will cover the costs of the stay up to a maximum of EUR 4,000.00 per person. This includes the expenses for accommodation, travel, possible travel expenses within Schleswig-Holstein as well as the expenses incurred in the exercise of the profession, e.g. for communication, and pocket money.
